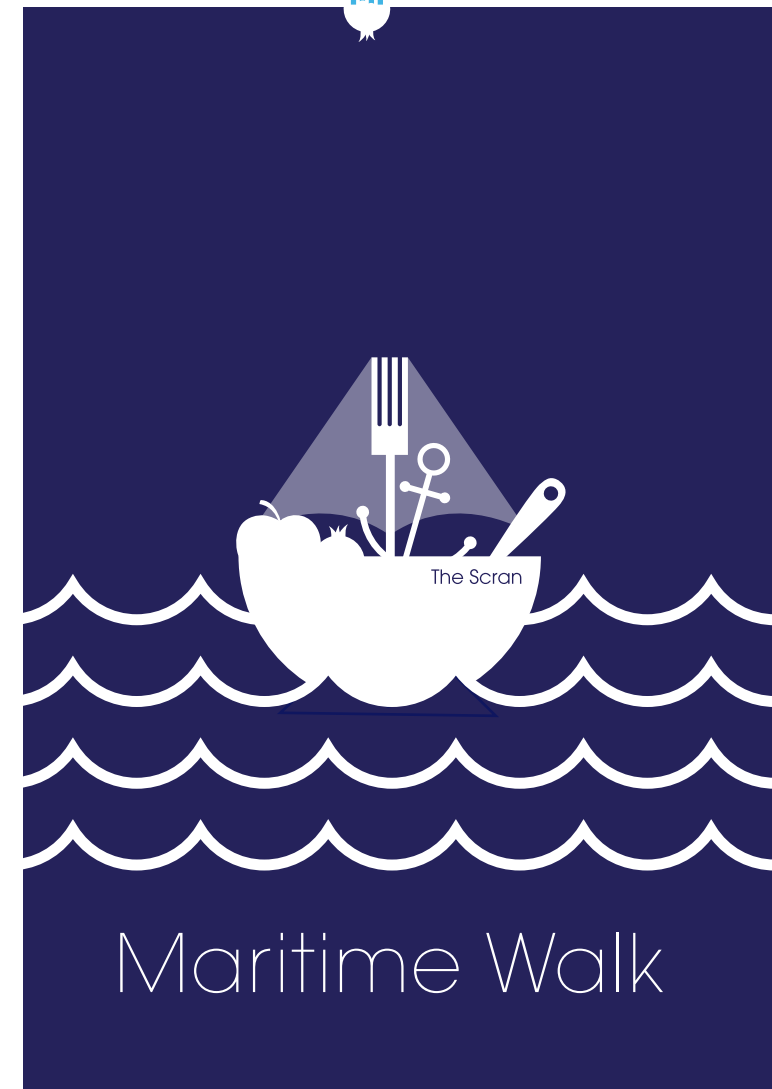
Welcome to Liverpool
