Granby Four Streets Community Market

**Held on the first Saturday in the month from April
til September, 10.30 til 3.30pm Granby Street L8 2TX**

The Granby Four Streets Market has become a much loved part of the community and is a reflection of the cultural mix of the area. Stalls range from bric-a-brac and second hand clothes to arts, crafts, bike repairs and henna painting, bread and hot food.

Woolton Farmers' Market

Lark Lane, L17 8UP



Garston Market


Speke Road, Garston, L19 2PA
